RE: Pension Relief for Public Education

Employer contribution rates for California State Teachers' Retirement System (CalSTRS) and California Public Employees' Retirement System (CalPERS) are scheduled to increase in 2022-23, resulting in \$1.2 billion in increased costs for local educational agencies (LEA) and community colleges. These costs come directly out of school and college budgets, diverting critical funds out of the classroom, where they are needed most.

With inflation rates at the highest level the nation has seen in 40 years at an estimated 7.9 percent and a proposed cost of living adjustment (COLA) of 5.33 percent for LEAs and community colleges, public education across the state will experience diminished buying and operational capacity, at a time when student need has never been higher. Absent a contribution from the general fund to keep the contribution rates flat in 2022-23, LEAs and community colleges will see rate increases in CalSTRS of approximately 2.18 percent and 2.16 percent for CalPERS. This is a single-year pension cost increase of \$1.2 billion starting July 1, 2022 and takes funds away from student services in every school and community college in the state.



We respectfully request a \$3.5 billion non-Proposition 98 General Fund payment on the behalf of LEAs and community colleges to CalSTRS and the CalPERS Schools Pool. Of this amount, an estimated \$1.2 billion would sustain the employer contribution rates in the short-term. The remaining \$2.3 billion would reduce employers' long-term unfunded liability for both systems. This will provide significant relief to LEAs and community colleges for the rising costs of pensions, both now and in the future and keep critical dollars in the classroom to support students.

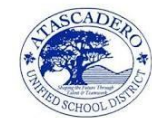
